**ATTENTION: If you are bringing your child to school in the mornings please DO NOT park or stop behind the buses. The buses pull up to the back door and must back up to get out of the parking lot. If you are stopped behind them, they can't get out and it causes a bottleneck where nobody can move.**

**VERY IMPORTANT: We are once again having a MAJOR problem with cell phones at school. On page 12 of our handbook, it states: "Use of cell phones, pagers, or electronic communication devices will not be allowed in the classroom or hallway. Students, who are found to be using any form of unauthorized electronic equipment outside of the permitted time, will have the equipment taken away. The equipment will be brought to the office to be picked up after school." Several students have been caught with cell phones at unauthorized times. Starting next week, all teachers and Mrs. Simcoe will have baskets or some other collection device in their rooms. Any student who brings a phone to school for after school activities will need to turn their phones in to their teacher or Mrs. Simcoe. If any student is caught with their phone once they arrive at school, the phone will be confiscated by staff and a parent/guardian will have to come to the school to retrieve it. Additional offenses will result in additional consequences.**

**MSTEP testing will be starting immediately after our Spring Break. This is a State REQUIRED test. To make sure that your child tests to the best of his/her ability, please make sure that he/she is attending school, well rested, and fed, each day. The 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be testing from 4/9 through 5/4. Grades 3,4, and 6 will be testing 4/30-5/25. We also ask that you do NOT take any extended vacations after Spring Break unless you have checked with your child's teacher first to verify the testing schedule and make up days.**

**All absences/vacations of more than 5 consecutive school days MUST be pre-approved by Mr. Radovich at least one week prior to the absence. This means vacations that are not scheduled by the school district.**

**Hunters' Safety for WES students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be held on April 16, 17, 23, and 24 from 3-5 pm.**
