Any kind of controlled medication, such as medication for ADHD, requires a form to be filled out by the parent/guardian and the prescribing doctor. This medication must also be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian. ALL medications will be kept in the office at all times. Students are NOT allowed to possess any medications.**
