

A folder and notebook will be used in the following classes: Social Studies, Science, Math, and Language Arts. Try to color code notebooks and folders. For example, if you choose a red notebook for Social Studies match it with a red pocket folder. You do not have to buy the expensive folders; the plain paper pocket folders work just fine. If your child's organizational skills are weak, you may want to consider purchasing an expanding accordion-like folder instead of individual folders. For Math a 2 inch three-ring binder and loose-leaf paper will be used.

Before school begins, most of the stores run specials on school supplies. Purchase the items listed above at that time, as well as extras that will be needed as the year progresses. Pencils, loose-leaf paper/notebooks and erasers will also need to be resupplied throughout the year, so stock up when the sales are on.

The school will provide an assignment notebook for each student. We will expect them to be used. It is a good communication tool between school and home. If your child loses this notebook, we will ask him/her to buy another one.
