To be considered highly qualified, paraprofessionals/aides must meet one of the following requirements:

- Complete at least two years as a student at an institution of higher education (equal to 60 semester hours); **or**
- Obtain an associate's degree (or higher) **or**
- Meet a rigorous standard of quality and demonstrate, through a formal state or local academic assessment:
 - Knowledge of, and the ability to assist in, instruction reading, writing and mathematics; or
 - Knowledge of, or the ability to assist in, instruction reading readiness, writing readiness or mathematics readiness, as appropriate.

For the Elementary & High School At Risk Position – This person will be working with:

1. Students in grades K-3 who are identified as needing interventions in the area of English Language Arts in order to have the skills needed to show proficiency on the 3rd grade M Step ELA Evaluation.
2. Students in grades 4-8 who are identified as needing interventions in the area of Mathematics in order to achieve the skills needed to show proficiency on the 8th grade M Step Math Evaluation.
3. Students in grades 7 and 8 who are identified as needed interventions in the areas of skill building, writing, test taking, study skills, etc. in order to show proficiency on the SAT test and college readiness.
